







Are political representatives adequate informing citizens about integration of Judiciary?












Do you know when integration of judiciary was supposed to be completed?

Do you know what are the reasons for delay of integration of judiciary





Do you think that the reasons for delay are of political or tehnical nature?



Is there political will of Prishtina for implementation of Agreement on Judiciary?


Is there political will of Belgrade for implementation of Agreement on Judiciary?




