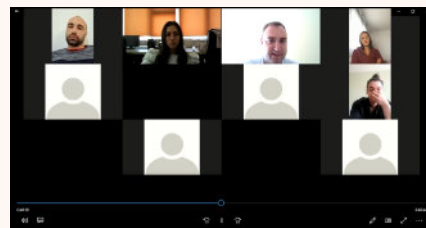
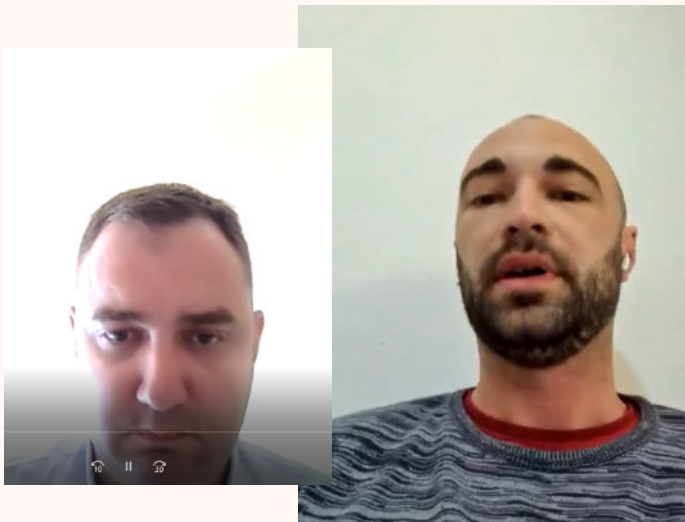




TRAINING "SCHOOL OF HUMAN RIGHTS"

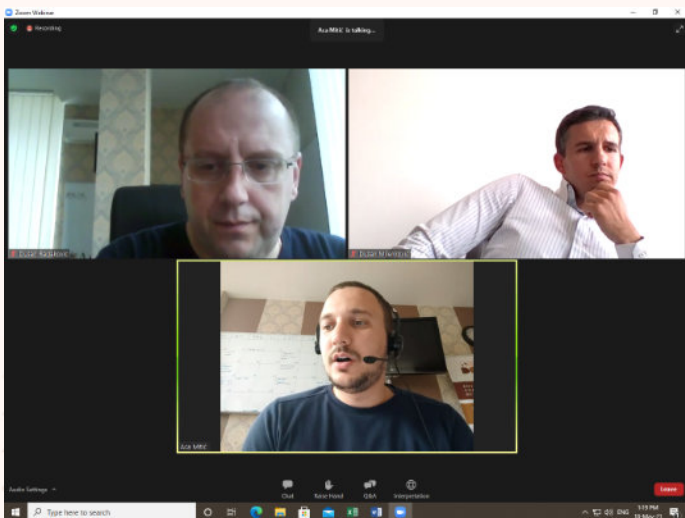

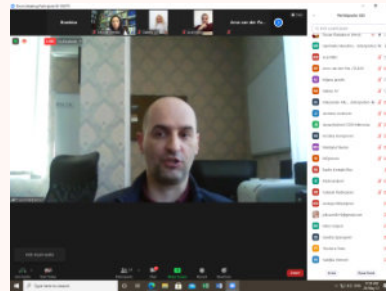
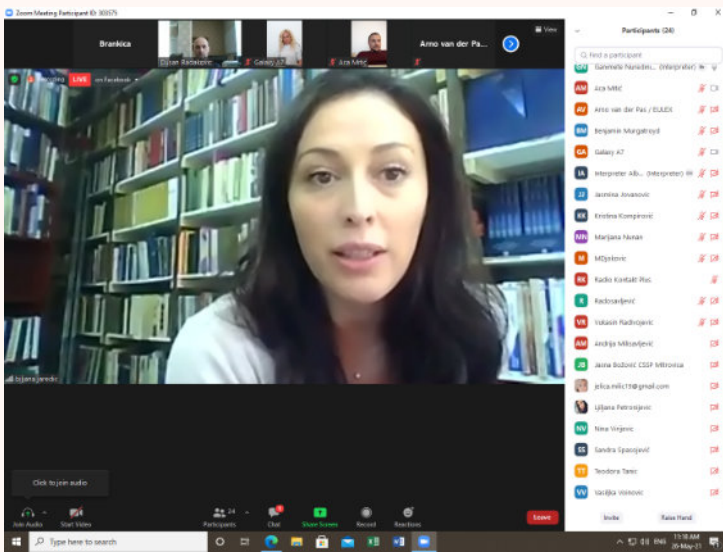

On May 26th, the NGO Center for the Advocacy of Democratic Culture organized a public discussion on "Juvenile delinquency in northern Kosovo during the COVID-19 pandemic." The panelists at the conference were Ms. Biljana Jaredić, psychologist, professor at the University of Pristina with temporary headquarters in Kosovska Mitrovica, Ms. Milena Milić, Social Rehabilitation Specialist, Center for Social Work and Mr. Jugoslav Bogavac, Supervisor of the Department for Investigation of Domestic Violence and Juvenile Delinquency. The panelists presented the problem of juvenile delinquency, some of the reasons why it happens, and also ways to prevent delinquency.

The conference was attended by lawyers, civil society activists, representatives of international organizations and the media, and others.
