Role of the Kosovo Police:

Protecting life and property

Maintaining public order and safety

Preventing and detecting crime

Protecting human rights and freedoms

Treating all citizens equally, regardless of race, color, religion, gender, or age

Are you a victim of a crime or an offense, or have you witnessed one?

The conduct of police officers is based on the following principles:

- Equal and fair treatment of all individuals;
- Respect for fundamental human rights and freedoms;
- Impartiality and neutrality concerning political beliefs and opinions;
- Integrity, honesty, and accountability in public service;
- Transparency—providing information to citizens and being open to the public;
- Legitimacy, adaptability, and proportionality.

If a police officer violates any of the above, the report should be submitted to the Police Inspectorate of Kosovo, which will conduct an investigation and punish the offender if the report is found to be accurate.
